*Sluam and Coburn, Bibliography, below, includes a section on Joyce men (including unpubl works), and gives locations in public institutions and the Sluam Library. Principal collections are at the BM (Finnegans walk), New York Public Library, Yale Univ (the Sluam Library includes Dubliners), National Library of Ireland (includes A portrait of the artist as a young man, and the Joyce-Léon correspondence), the Rosenbach Foundation (Ulysses), State Univ of New York at Buffalo, and Cornell and Southern Illinois universities.*

*In view of the enormous quantity of secondary material on Joyce only a selection is given below. It is divided as follows: biographical studies, general studies of Joyce's work as a whole, and studies of individual works (arranged under the particular work). This arrangement corresponds broadly with that of Deming, Bibliography of Joyce Studies, where much fuller listings can be found: such listings of post-1968 material are available in Modern Fiction Stud 15 1969, and in the James Joyce Quart nos given above. Reviews are listed and excerpted in Joyce: the critical heritage, ed R. H. Deming 2 vols 1970.*

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
